



Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville Burkholder Neighbourhood Schedule B Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Notice of Study Commencement

The Project

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study to explore how Burkholder Street and the Leisure Centre Driveway should function as access points to the Burkholder Neighbourhood. The study will consider potential solutions for traffic routing, access, and pedestrian safety. The Town has retained CIMA+ to undertake this study.

The Process

The study is following the Municipal Engineers Association (MEA) Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process for Schedule B projects (October 2000, as amended in 2015). The Municipal Class Environmental Assessment is an approved planning and design process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

Two Public Information Centres (PICs) are planned for this project. The PICs will provide an opportunity for interested parties to discuss the study with the project team and provide feedback. The PICs will be scheduled at a later date, and advance notification will be provided.
