Purpose of the Study

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville is undertaking a Study for possible Greenbelt Area boundary adjustments and future employment growth along the Highway 404 corridor. The subject areas are predominately agricultural lands that are located outside of the Province's Greenbelt Area. Any potential refinements to the Greenbelt Area, would require approval by the Province and Region, and are intended to ensure that an equivalent amount of land will be maintained within the Greenbelt Area.

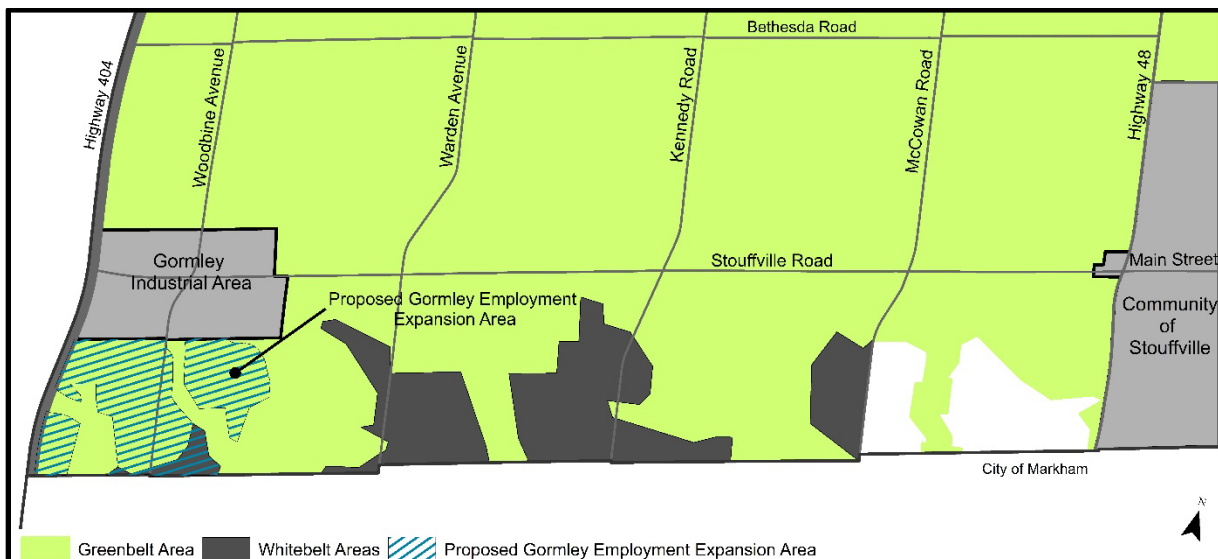
