Dear Carla,

This office has reviewed the above-mentioned report, which has been submitted to this Ministry as a condition of licensing in accordance with Part VI of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c 0.18. This review is to ensure that the licensed professional consultant archaeologist has met the terms and conditions of their archaeological licence, that archaeological sites have been identified and documented according to the 1993 technical guidelines set by the Ministry and that the archaeological fieldwork and report recommendations ensure the conservation, protection and preservation of the cultural heritage of Ontario.

As the result of our review, this Ministry accepts the above titled report into the Provincial register of archaeological reports. The report indicates that portions of the subject property have archaeological potential and, consequently, should be subject to a Stage 2 archaeological assessment. This Ministry concurs with this recommendation.

The report indicates that the northern portion of the subject property has been severely disturbed due to 20th century quarrying, and consequently has no further archaeological potential. Phase 1 of the proposed development lies entirely within this area of no archaeological potential.

Given the above, this Ministry is satisfied that concerns for archaeological sites have been met for Phase 1 of this development project as depicted by Figure 7 of the above titled report.

This letter is not a concurrence with recommendations that there are no further archaeological concerns for Phase 2 or Phase 3 of the proposed development. In order for this Ministry to concur with any recommendation that there are no further archaeological concerns for Phase 2, we will require the opportunity to review a detailed survey of the property, Draft Plan or similarly detailed mapping in order to confirm that Phase 2 lies entirely within the areas formerly impacted by quarrying.

This office has reviewed the above-mentioned report, which has been submitted to this ministry as a condition of licensing in accordance with Part VI of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c 0.18.¹ This review has been carried out in order to determine whether the licensed professional consultant archaeologist has met the terms and conditions of their licence, that the licensee assessed the property and documented archaeological resources using a process that accords with the 2011 Standards and Guidelines for Consultant Archaeologists set by the ministry, and that the archaeological fieldwork and report recommendations are consistent with the conservation, protection and preservation of the cultural heritage of Ontario.

The report documents the assessment of the study area as depicted in Figure 3 and Appendix A of the above titled report and recommends the following:

The Stage 2 field assessment did not result in the identification of any archaeological sites and as a result no further assessment is recommended. This recommendation is supported by criteria set out in the Standards and Guidelines for Consultant Archaeologists (Government of Ontario 2011).

Lands south of the Stage 2 survey area, identified as retaining archaeological potential in the Stage 1 report, are not considered clear of archaeological concerns and are recommended for Stage 2 survey in advance of any ground disturbance activities.

Based on the information contained in the report, the ministry is satisfied that the fieldwork and reporting for the archaeological assessment are consistent with the ministry's 2011 Standards and Guidelines for Consultant Archaeologists and the terms and conditions for archaeological licences.
