In Case of Fire:	Activation of a Smoke OR Carbon Monoxide Alarm:
 Upon discovery of fire leave area immediately and close door. Safely notify all occupants. Leave building via nearest exit. Dial 9-1-1 from outside building. 	 Safely notify all occupants. Close doors behind you. Leave building via nearest exit. CAUTION: if you encounter smoke use an alternate exit. Dial 9-1-1 from outside the building.

Fire Prevention Measurers:

To redu	ice fire risk and life safety hazards:
×	Do not place burning materials such as cigarettes and ashes into garbage.
\checkmark	Do not dispose of flammable liquids or aerosol cans in garbage or burning appliances.
\checkmark	Lint trap in dryer to be cleaned after each use.
\checkmark	Space heaters to be placed at least 1 meter from any combustible material.
	If using candles, ensure they are secured in a sturdy holder away from any combustible materials. Always extinguish candles before leaving any room and going to bed.
\checkmark	Do not block exit doors.
\triangleright	Hallways and service/storage areas to be kept neat and tidy.
\checkmark	Do not use unsafe electrical appliances, frayed cords or overloaded outlets.
\checkmark	Extension cords are not to be used as permanent wiring.
Do not	attempt to cook while tired or under the influence of drugs or alcohol:
\checkmark	Food preparation only in areas designed for cooking.
	Avoid unsafe cooking practices: Deep fat frying Unattended cooking Excessive heat Loosely hanging sleeves/clothing/hair
